Cookies Policy ONLINEYOUNET

This Cookies Policy (the "Policy") describes what information the Company (hereinafter - "ONLINEYOUNET", represented by Private Entrepreneur I. P. Nepochtova) collects about you and why, and how the Company uses the collected information.

1. Do we use COOKIES?

- 1.1. Yes. The Company uses cookies, web beacons, and other similar technologies to collect information about the pages you view, the links you click, and other actions you take in connection with your visit and use of the Site.
- 1.2. A cookie is a small file, usually consisting of letters and numbers, that is downloaded to a device when a User visits certain Web sites and helps the site recognize the User's Web browser or device on repeated visits. The Company uses cookies for the purposes of:
 - technical cookies are necessary for the Site to work correctly;
 - functional cookies are required to remember User preferences, in particular the preferred language, search history and telecommunications services that the User has previously browsed. Such cookies are necessary to make the Site more convenient to use;
 - analytical cookies are needed to know how Users use the Site, in particular, what pages the User visited, from which pages the User went and to which pages, from which pages the User left the Site, the number of mouse clicks on a particular page, the User's search queries. Such cookies are necessary to optimize the Site and improve its performance;
 - commercial cookies are necessary to show the User the Company's advertisements on other sites. That is, the User is shown ads for offers that he had previously viewed, as well as previously viewed telecommunications services.
- 1.3. You can block, disable and delete cookies, web beacons and other similar items if your web browser or device allows you to do so.
